Make Your Own Piñata!

What You'll Need:

Paper lunch bag

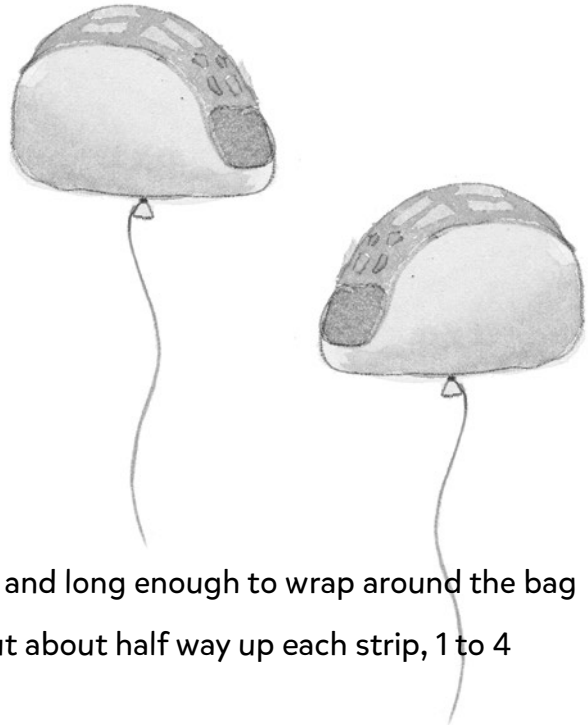
Newspaper

Candy or other treats

Different colors of tissue paper

Scissors

Glue, Hole punch & String



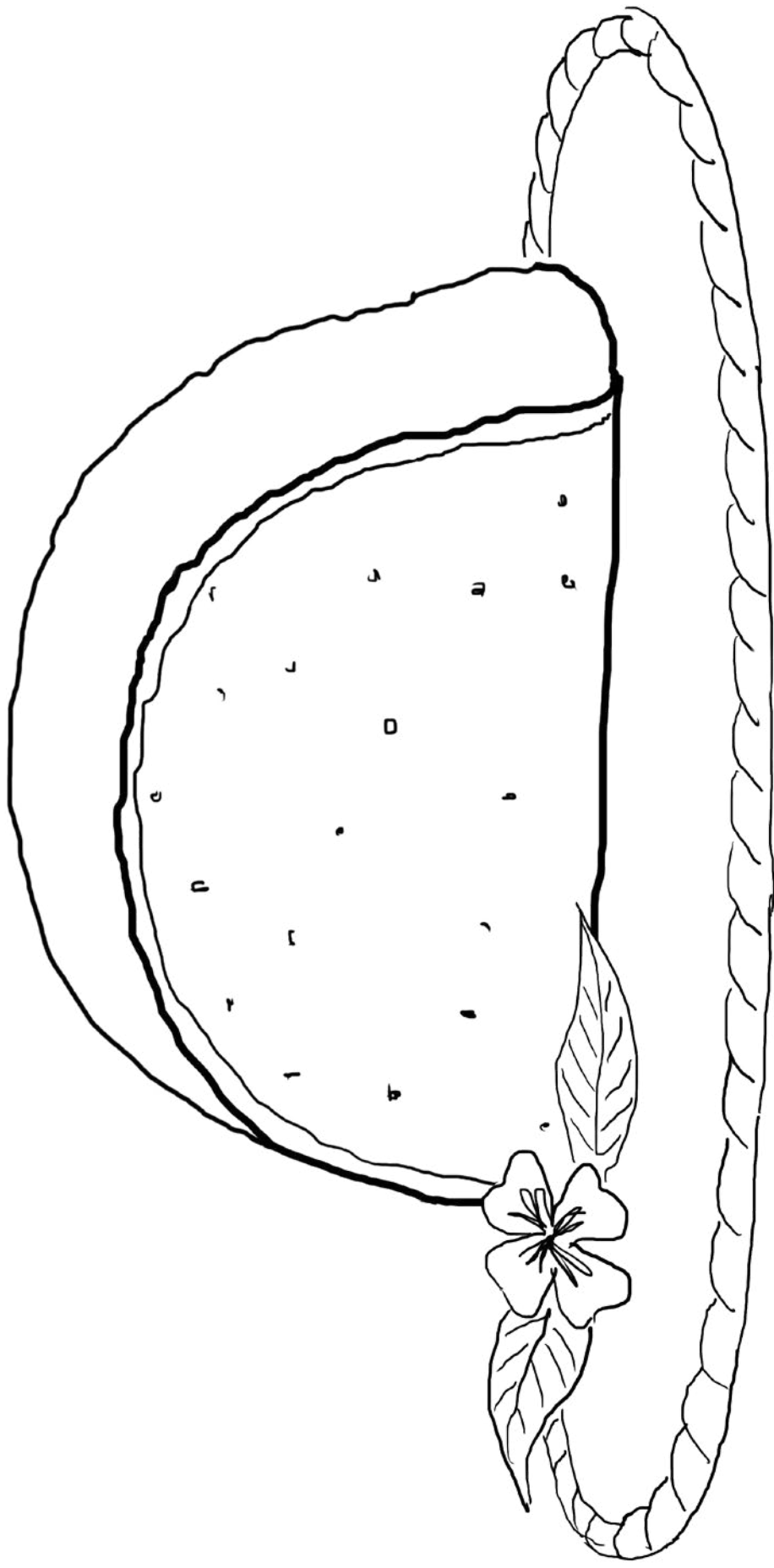
Instructions:

- Cut strips of tissue paper 3 to 6 inches wide and long enough to wrap around the bag
- Fringe the strips by using your scissors to cut about half way up each strip, 1 to 4 inches apart
- Glue the top of the strips to the back starting from the bottom, overlaying the fringe of the next strip to cover the top of the one under it
- Repeat until you've covered the entire bag—again leaving about 1 inch free at the top
- Put candy or treats into the paper bag
- Scrunch up pieces of newspaper until the bag is full, stopping 1 inch from the top
- Glue or tape the bag shut
- Punch a hole at the top of the bag
- Lace a piece of string or yarn through the hole and pull tight and tie in a loop so you can hang it.
- Cut 4 or 5 long strips of tissue paper and glue them to the bottom of the bag as streamers
- Hang up for decoration or take turns breaking open the piñatas!
